

*Tasting Report Brunello di Montalcino Sesta di Sopra*

<b>93</b>	Brunello di Montalcino	<b>2005</b>	<i>This is a layered and fresh 2005 Brunello, with dried fruits, sweet tobacco and cedar character. Full and very silky. Makes me want to drink. I always love this tiny producer's Brunellos.</i>
<b>94</b>	Brunello di Montalcino	<b>2006</b>	<i>Amazing aromas of blackberries, sandalwood and dried flowers. Full body, with chewy tannins and a powerful mouth feel of loads of fruit. Love the wet earth, meat and dark fruits. Needs another three to four years to soften.</i>
<b>93</b>	Brunello di Montalcino	<b>2007</b>	<i>Beautiful aromas of strawberries and flowers, follow through to a full body, with velvety tannins and a chewy finish. Needs time to soften. Delicious wines from here. Better in 2014.</i>
<b>91</b>	Brunello di Montalcino <b>Riserva</b>	<b>2007</b>	<i>Delicate and fruity with strawberry and floral character. Medium to full body, with fine tannins and a clean finish. More refined than normal bottling. Drink now.</i>
<b>90</b>	Brunello di Montalcino	<b>2008</b>	<i>A solid and chewy wine with layers of ripe tannins and cherry, chocolate character. Full and rich. A little disjointed now. Better in 2014.</i>
<b>91</b>	Brunello di Montalcino <b>Riserva</b>	<b>2008</b>	<i>Delicate and fruity with strawberry and floral character. Medium to full body, with fine tannins and a clean finish. More refined than normal bottling. Drink now.</i>
<b>94</b>	Brunello di Montalcino	<b>2010</b>	<i>A beautiful red with berry, chocolate and plum aromas. Iodine and oyster shell undertones. It's full body and dense with a beautiful depth of fruit and richness. Firm and fine tannins. Need four to five years of bottle age to soften.</i>
<b>94</b>	Brunello di Montalcino <b>Riserva</b>	<b>2010</b>	<i>Complete and complex Brunello with plum, floral and dried meat aromas and flavors. Full body, silky tannins and a flavorful finish. Salty and savory. Drink or hold.</i>
<b>92</b>	Brunello di Montalcino	<b>2011</b>	<i>Very fine and delicate with a dense and compacted palate, fine tannins with dark chocolate and stone undertones. Extremely elegant yet structure. Drink now or hold.</i>
